Parents' Info Sheet

Doddle is an online teaching and learning resource that allows students to access and complete their homework online, and provides access to hundreds of revision materials. As a parent, this Info Sheet will help you understand how to use Doddle to support and encourage your son/daughter to complete their homework and use Doddle for revision and learning outside of the classroom.

Using Doddle for Homework

It's not just that students prefer doing everything (even homework!) online, it's that by making Doddle accessible online we can give students access to exciting, interactive resources that make learning more interesting, memorable and even fun.

Logging in to Doddle:

1. Go to www.doddlelearn.co.uk
2. Click on the 'Login' button in the top right-hand corner of the screen.
3. Enter the name of your son/daughter's institution.
4. Log in with your son/daughter's school email address or provided username and password.

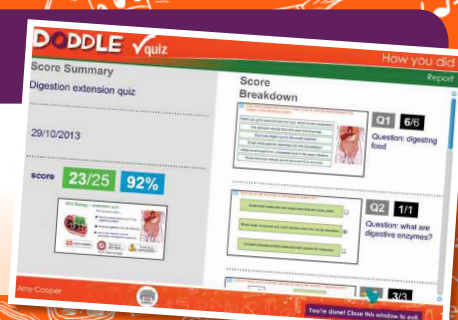
Staying organised: To Do list

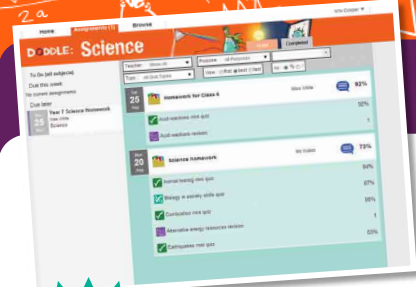


To help your son/daughter stay on top of their Doddle homeworks, the student To Do list clearly lists all homeworks in date order. Talk to your son/daughter about what work they need to do on their To Do list, including any extra instructions given by their teacher.

Staying on track: Seeing Results

At the end of a homework quiz, you'll see a report page, giving your son/daughter's score. In the Completed tab you can also see a record of all their homework results, helping you stay aware of how they're doing.





Going further: Re-taking the quiz

Seeing their results at the end of each homework quiz challenges students to re-take quizzes and improve their scores. In the Completed tab, you'll be able to see their score for their First, Best and Last attempt at the quiz.

Top Tips!

- Keep a record of your son/daughter's login details
- Ask to see their results on a regular basis and encourage them to aim for 100%
- Check their To Do list – have they got any overdue work?

Using Doodle to learn outside of the classroom

A key way in which Doodle can help you support your son/daughter's education, is by using it to support learning outside of the classroom. Whilst Doodle is used by teachers to teach lessons and assign homework, students can also use Doodle on their own, outside of the classroom, to help them take control of their own learning.

Homework help:

By heading to the **Browse** tab, students can search and browse all the teaching resources available in Doodle. Each resource in Doodle will support your son/daughter in different ways:



Presentations – covering entire topics, these are really helpful for topics that need to be recapped from the very beginning.



Revision – targeting specific areas, these are great for a quick refresher.



Interactives – stuck on one key idea? Animated interactives are great for illustrating a key idea in a clear and memorable way.

When exams do arrive, Doodle offers students the complete revision package.

Targeting revision:

Encourage your son/daughter to use the Completed tab to look at past results and identify strengths and weaknesses. Help them use this information to prioritise their revision.

Revision resources:

In the Browse tab, students can use presentations, revision and interactives to help them understand the topics they find most challenging.
