Recommended Resources

- Pupil struggling due to poor attendance/lack of effort in lessons? We recommend they have access to a **CGP Revision guide** (either SFR31 (level 3-6) or SHR31 (level 5-7)) to help bolster their notes. Pupils should read sections that they have missed, and make notes on the relevant pages to help fill in the gaps.
- Pupil struggling to demonstrate their knowledge in tests and assessed pieces of work? We recommend they have access to a **CGP Workbook** (either SHW31B (level 3-6) or SFW31B (level 5-7)) to help practice using what they have learned in a range of activities. Pupils should attempt some tasks on a subject (more or fewer depending on their confidence level) at home, following on from activities in the classroom.
- Pupil struggling with the numeracy/mathematical aspect of Science? We recommend they have access to a **CGP Maths Skills Book** (SMR41 *and* SMA41 for the answers), and work through the different sections as they come across the required skills in lessons.
