Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our programme for preparing our students for their exams, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations to begin on **Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> April 2018** until **Friday, 11<sup>th</sup> May 2018**. These mock examinations are designed to give students a realistic experience of an examination setting, and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts for the remainder of the academic year. The timetable for these exams can be found accompanying this letter on the school website.

I would encourage all pupils to take these exams very seriously in the coming weeks and to devote quality time to revision. Subject staff will also be advising pupils what they need to revise, which should help to give them focus in the weeks before the exams.

Please note these key details about the mock exam period:

- All pupils should be wearing normal school uniform and during the mock exam period your child will either be taking an examination or attending normal lessons.
- If your child is unable to attend an examination due to illness, please telephone the school as soon as possible.
- The examinations will take place in full accordance with GCSE regulations and conditions. As part of these regulations, students must not have on their person any electronic device (e.g. phone, iPod etc.). Such items must be left at home or left in their locker at the start of the day.
- The examinations are extremely important because they will provide students with valuable practice and experience under examination conditions.
- The results of any mock exams will be distributed before the end of the academic year.
- It is very important that every student is fully equipped for the exams. We would expect your child to have a **black pen**, pencils, a ruler, eraser, sharpener, pair of compasses, a protractor and a calculator (where permitted) all in a clear pencil case. An exam equipment pack can be purchased from The Cabin for £2.50.
