

Dear parent/Carer,

With the Year 11 final exam only 6 months away I need to start to finalise your son/daughters three sports that will be submitted for their practical assessment. We have been assessing sports that we have undertaken in GCSE PE lessons over the last 15 months. What I need now is evidence of performance in sports that students do outside of school that we have not assessed on the KS 4 curriculum.

Students who want to be assessed on a sport need to gather video evidence. Your child should have already received the assessment criteria produced by the exam board from your teacher. This includes the core and advanced skills, physical attributes and tactical decision making. It is vital that the footage on the video is of high quality and shows all the skills (both core and advanced) in isolation and in a competitive game situation. The video must also show evidence of your child applying strategies and tactics and using decision making. There should be some verbal dialogue throughout the video explaining what skills or tactics are being shown in each section of the video.

I would like the video on a memory stick by 31st January 2019.
