Dear Parents/Carers

**Re: Incident Near Brockington College on Wednesday 5 December 2018**

Further to my previous letter regarding the above incident, I am writing to provide an update on the current situation.

The advice from the police remains that pupils should not use the lane that connects Mill Lane to Narborough on their way to and from school as a precaution.

As you will be aware, the school placed additional members of staff on duty at the entrance to the lane after school on Thursday and Friday of last week to prevent pupils accessing that route home to avoid any potential danger to them. From today, although members of staff will be on duty at the school gates, there will be no additional staffing at the entrance to the lane after school preventing access to pupils.

Our advice, in line with that of the police, is that pupils do not use the lane on their way to school in the mornings and home again at the end of the school day. I would be grateful if you would discuss this matter with your child.
