Re: Year 11 Mock Examinations - March 2019

With around 12 school weeks until the GCSE exams begin it is very important that all Year 11 students reflect upon the successes and failures of the December mock exams and devote themselves to a final drive for success.

In order to aid these final preparations, we have scheduled another short series of mock examinations to begin on **Monday, 18th March 2019** until **Friday, 22nd March 2019**. These exams will involve predominantly the core and humanities subjects, and a timetable for the week is included with this letter. This is a chance for all students to act on the feedback they have received in class and show that they can make it count in the summer, so it is vital that all Year 11s take these exams seriously, learn from their errors in December and strive for excellence!

As in December, subject staff will also be advising pupils what they need to revise and all departments have now set up after school revision sessions; staff will be advising pupils to attend these sessions where they feel it would be beneficial and I would recommend that all students take these opportunities. Any revision in preparation for these exams will only benefit students in their summer exams.
