### Year 10 Mock Examinations

As part of our programme for preparing Year 10 pupils for their exams, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations to begin on **Monday 17 June 2019** until **Friday 28 June 2019**. These mock examinations are designed to give pupils a realistic experience of an examination setting and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts for the remainder of the academic year. The timetable for these exams can be found accompanying this letter on the school website. A list of revision topics and resources will be distributed to pupils in the coming days.

I would encourage all Year 10 pupils to take these exams very seriously in the coming weeks and to devote quality time to revision. Subject staff will be advising pupils what they need to revise, which should help to give them focus in the weeks before the exams.

Please note these key details about the mock exam period:

- All pupils must wear school uniform during the mock exam period, as they will either be taking an examination or attending normal lessons.
- If your child is unable to attend an examination due to illness, please telephone the school as soon as possible.
- The examinations will take place in full accordance with GCSE regulations and conditions. As part of these regulations, pupils must not have on their person any electronic device (eg phone, iPod etc). Such items **must** be left at home or in their locker at the start of the day.
- The examinations are extremely important because they will provide pupils with valuable practice and experience of examination conditions.
- The results of the mock exams will be distributed before the end of the academic year.
- It is very important that pupils are fully equipped for the exams. We would expect your child to have a **black pen**, pencils, a ruler, eraser, sharpener, pair of compasses, a protractor and a calculator (where permitted) which must be kept in a clear pencil case. An exam equipment pack can be purchased from The Cabin at school for £2.50.
