Brockington College Post 16 and Careers Evening

I am writing to invite you to the Brockington College Post 16 and Careers Evening on Wednesday 2 October 2019 between 6pm and 8:30pm. During this event your son/daughter will have the opportunity to speak to an array of post-16 providers, employers and universities. The purpose of the evening is to encourage students to start to think about their next steps after they leave Brockington College.
