In order to complete the mock examination process, we have scheduled a mock results morning for **Monday 16 December 2019** during which each student will be given an envelope containing a breakdown of their performance during the mock exam series. They will also receive a reflection sheet to help them think about their preparation for, and performance in, the mock exams.
