Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Show My Homework access

Currently schools across the UK are preparing for the possibility of closure due to the Coronavirus. At this point, we don't know if or when this is likely to happen nor do we know how long any period of closure would last. Should this scenario occur, then we will inform parents/carers and provide more detail at that point.

However, in order that we are ready for such a scenario, our teaching staff have been preparing work and programmes of study. Should we be in a position where the school needs to close, our expectation of students would be that they continue to work at home in the same way that they would have done had they been present in school. Therefore, staff will be setting work daily which students will be expected to complete and return to their teachers for feedback.

At Brockington College you will know that we use Show My Homework as a homework setting mechanism. Should we need to close, then the intention is that work will be set for students to complete through Show My Homework, as this is already our normal way of working and both students and parents/carers are familiar with this tool.

So that we can ensure that all students are able to complete work at home should the need arise, we are asking parents/carers to let us know if they or their child are not able to access Show My Homework or need further help to make sure they are fully set up.
