## Re: Year 11 Easter revision sessions

As part of our drive to prepare our students for the rigours of the GCSE examinations this summer, we have scheduled a series of revision sessions to take place during the Easter break. These will take place from Monday 6 April 2020 to Friday 17 April 2020 (excluding Friday 10 April and Monday 13 April 2020).

In most cases, the sessions provided are focused on specific elements of the course so that students are able to choose which sessions will be of greatest benefit to their revision. To book onto any of the revision sessions, please go to our online booking portal: <http://brockingtoncollege.eventbrite.com/> and select the sessions your child wishes to attend by **Friday 27 March 2020**. We have tried to offer as many sessions with as many spaces as possible, however this will depend on the number of staff able to support during the fortnight, so sessions must be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis. Any students who have not been able to secure their first choice will be informed in the week prior to the Easter break.

In order to cover some of the costs, we do ask for a small payment of £20 per student, which will allow them to attend as many sessions as they wish over the course of the fortnight. This payment should be made via ParentPay between 13 March and 27 March 2020. If your child is entitled to Pupil Premium funding, there will be no charge for attending the revision sessions. If you require any further information about Pupil Premium funding, please contact Mr Higham who will advise you further.

Whilst I am conscious of the anxieties caused by the national situation with COVID-19, as a school we felt it was best to continue planning for our annual Easter revision sessions for Year 11 and to make arrangements as normal. Clearly, we will keep parents/carers informed if there are any changes either to the schedule or to the event as a whole.
