## RE: Year 11 after-school intervention sessions

Dear parents/carers

In order to support all year 11s with their exam preparation **we will be trialling the delivery of after school interventions online on Thursday 12 November and Friday 13 November 2020** to ensure that all students have access to the support they need whether they are in or out of the school building. These sessions will run through our Google Meets programme, which we have been using to deliver live lessons to students not attending school. **All students who wish to take part in the after-school intervention session should, if possible, do so from home.**

The sessions running on 12 and 13 November are outlined below, with the appropriate link to join each classroom. The timings for these sessions will be from 3.30pm-4.15pm, which should allow some time for students to return home and log into the system.

### Accessing the sessions

To access the revision sessions your son/daughter must follow the steps below.

- Go to **classroom.google.com** and sign in with your school email address and school password. Your school email account must be used; you will not be permitted to access using any other email address.
- Find and join the classroom relevant to the session you want to join from the table below. To join the classroom, click on the + in the top right-hand corner and choose 'join class'.
- Click on the Google Meet link located at the top of the course page.
