Re: Year 11 mock exam timetable – December 2020

As part of our programme for preparing our year 11 students for their summer exams, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations to begin on **Wednesday 2 December 2020** until **Friday 18 December 2020**. The exams are designed to give students a realistic experience of an examination setting, and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts on the run up to the summer 2021 exams. I would encourage all students to take these exams seriously in the coming weeks and to devote quality time to revision. Subject staff will also be advising students what they need to revise and most departments have now set up after school revision sessions; staff will be advising students to attend these sessions where they feel it would be beneficial, and I would recommend that all students take these opportunities.
