Brockington College Post-16 and Careers Information Evening

I am writing to invite you to the Brockington College Post-16 and Careers Evening on Thursday 7 October 2021. During this event your son/daughter will have the opportunity to speak to an array of post-16 providers, employers and universities. The purpose of the evening is to encourage students to start to think about their next steps after they leave Brockington College.

The evening will also help your child develop an insight into the knowledge and skills required when moving on from school into post-16 provision. All students are now expected to stay in some form of education or training until the age of 18; this event will provide them with an appreciation of the options available to them when they finish their GCSEs.
