Re: Year 10 Key Stage 4 Introduction

As students embark on their Key Stage 4 courses, we are conscious that it can seem daunting and that families might need some guidance about what to expect and how to support one another over the next two years. To support parents and carers in preparing students for the rigours of Key Stage 4 and to understand the key milestones over the next two years, we have organised a 'Strategies for Success' evening on Wednesday 15 September 2021 from 6:30pm at Brockington College.

During this session, Mrs Batstone and I will present on the key principles of revision, including our revision planner; how to access and use key resources to support your child such as the college revision website; and how to support your child through their Key Stage 4 courses. We will be running this session in person and I would encourage all year 10 families to attend, if possible, to ensure that you receive all the relevant guidance and that you have a chance to ask any questions you may have. Year 11 families have also been invited to this event to support their children in the final year of their studies.

The session is aimed predominantly at parents/carers, as students will also receive important information in the coming weeks at school.
