### Re: Year 11 mock examinations and preparation

As part of our programme for preparing year 11 students for their summer exams, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations to begin on **Monday, 7 March 2022** until **Friday, 18 March 2022**. As with previous mock exams, they are designed to give students a realistic experience of an examination setting, and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts on the run up to the summer 2022 exams. This series of mock exams will be a chance for all students to act on feedback from their November mocks, and so it is very important that students listen to advice from their teachers, plan for them carefully, and devote quality time to their revision.

To support families in preparing for the mock exams and to understand the key milestones for year 11 this academic year, we have organised another *Strategies for Success* evening for **Thursday 27 January 2022** from 6pm at Brockington College. During this session, Mrs Batstone and I will present on the key principles of revision, including our revision planner; how to access and use key resources to support your child such as the college revision website; and how to support your child through a stressful year.


