Dear Parents/Carers

Re: Year 10 Mock Examinations

As part of our programme to prepare students for their examinations at the end of year 11, we have scheduled a series of mock examinations for all year 10 students to take place over two weeks from **Tuesday 3 May 2021** until **Friday 13 May 2022**. These mock examinations are designed to give students a realistic experience of an examination setting, and a chance to judge where they need to focus their efforts for the remainder of the academic year and into the beginning of year 11. The timetable for these exams can be found accompanying this letter on the [school website](#). Students will be given a full breakdown of what to revise, including access to knowledge organisers and directions to revision material, by their teachers in the coming weeks.

In a very small number of cases, students may have a clash whereby they have two exams taking place at the same time due to scheduling constraints; in such cases, students will sit the longer of the two exams in that slot, and the shorter exam will be sat at another time within the exam period. All students affected in this way will be told about these arrangements in advance.

I would encourage all students to take these exams seriously in the coming weeks and to devote quality time to revision. Students have already been given advice about where to find revision material, how to plan their revision at the beginning of the summer term, and how to use the college revision website.

Please note these key details about the mock exam period.

- If your child is unable to attend an examination due to illness, please telephone the school as soon as possible.
- The examinations will take place in full accordance with GCSE regulations and conditions and will be invigilated by our team of external exam invigilators. As part of these regulations, students must not have any electronic device on their person (e.g. smart phone, etc.). Such items **must** be left at home or left in students' lockers before the exam.
- The examinations are very important because they will provide students with valuable practice and experience under examination conditions; they will also give students and teachers a clear idea of any gaps in knowledge or exam technique.
- The results of any mock exams will be distributed before the end of the academic year, and will also help to inform grade predictions for college applications in the autumn term
- It is very important that every student is fully equipped for the exams. We would expect your child to have at least one **black pen**, pencils, a ruler, eraser, sharpener, pair of compasses, a protractor and a calculator all in a clear pencil case. An exam equipment pack can be purchased online through ParentPay.
