End of summer term arrangements

As the end of term approaches, I am writing to confirm our arrangements for the end of this school year. The last few days remain a busy time. Mary Poppins, our summer musical, performances take place this Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday and sports day takes place on Wednesday. Friday 1 July is the year 10 reward trip to Alton Towers, followed by many year 10 students going out on work experience placements during the final week of term. On Monday 4 July and Tuesday 5 July, we welcome year 6 pupils for two transition days ahead of them joining us in August. Students in years 7, 8 and 9 will enjoy their reward trips on Tuesday 5 July. On Wednesday 6 July, all students will take part in the Brockington College infamous 'Oscars' reward assemblies. Please note that on Monday 4 July, Tuesday 5 July and Wednesday 6 July, the canteen will be offering a slightly reduced menu to enable the increased number of students to be served in the limited lunch period.

Last day of term - Thursday 7 July

School will close for the summer holidays at **12.25pm on Thursday 7 July 2022**. The school buses will arrive for **12.25pm** and will depart at approximately **12.40pm**. The final day of term will be non-uniform for students with a voluntary contribution of £1.00, payable via ParentPay, which will of course be donated to charity. Students in year 7, as part of their Archbishop of York project work, have nominated Leicester Animal Aid and Hope Against Cancer. The students were keen to raise money for these charities as they have a personal connection for many. We appreciate that the early finish may create childcare issues for some parents/carers. Therefore, there will be the facility for any child to stay in school and be supervised in the library until 3pm, although there will be no school buses at this time. As we head towards the end of term, we are saying a few goodbyes to valued teachers who are moving on to pastures new. My personal thanks go to Miss Parmar, Mr Green, Mrs Parmar-Hickey and Mr Conway for all they have contributed to Brockington and we wish them all the very best in their next ventures. We also say goodbye to Miss Wyeth after 30 years' service at Brockington College in the PE department; what an amazing achievement and we hope she enjoys a well-deserved break! We will be welcoming several new teachers to Brockington College. They are all looking forward to joining us and I will introduce them to parents and carers in the autumn term.
