Brockington College Post-16 and Careers Information Evening

I am writing to invite you to the Brockington College Post-16 and Careers Evening on **Thursday 6 October 2022 from 5pm-7pm**. During this event your son/daughter will have the opportunity to speak to an array of post-16 providers, employers and universities. The purpose of the evening is to encourage students to start to think about their next steps after they leave Brockington College.

The evening will also help your child develop an insight into the knowledge and skills required when moving on from school into post-16 provision. All students are now expected to stay in some form of education or training until the age of 18; this event will provide them with an appreciation of the options available to them when they finish their GCSEs.

The event is open to both year 10 and 11 students, as we feel it is important that your son/daughter starts to consider and engage with their career aspirations as early as possible. However, we would ask you to register and book a timeslot for either **5pm, 5.40pm or 6.20pm** to attend in order for us to regulate numbers on site. The event finishes at 7pm. Once the timeslot reaches capacity, this slot will show as full and another slot will need to be selected. These events are always busy and due to limited car parking available on site, please can we ask that you walk to school if at all possible; if you need to drive please consider car sharing to minimise the number of vehicles onsite and ensure that you drive and park considerately.
