Live lessons can be accessed by visiting <u>https://classroom.google.com/</u> and signing in with your school email and password
From here you should have a list of all classes you are enrolled in. If any of your classes are missing please contact IT Support on itsupport@brockington.embracemat.org
Live lessons will be delivered in line with your school timetable (also available on Show My Homework)
To access the lesson please find the appropriate classroom at the normal timetabled lesson time and select Join from the menu on the left-hand side of the screen.
Please ensure that your webcam and microphone are turned off – indicated by the icons on the right – and then click Join Now
You will then be either entered directly into the live lesson, or into a waiting area if the teacher has not joined the classroom.
If the lesson has not started within 10 minutes of the scheduled lesson start-time then please assume that the teacher is unavailable and use the time to complete homework

Please ensure the platform is used responsibly at all times including:

- Ensuring cameras remain off at all times.
- Chat windows are enabled for students to ask questions relating to the topic being taught. Please do not disrupt learning by using it for any other reason.
- If it is found that you are disrupting learning using this platform, access to the service may be revoked and may be subject to the school behaviour policy
