





Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Parent Governor Vacancy

I am writing to inform you of a vacancy for a parent governor to join the school's local governing board.





You do not need to be an expert in education to be a school governor, and we value the variety of experience and skills that all of our governors bring to the role. However vou will be expected to demonstrate skills and experience that will enhance governance at the school, a commitment to undertake training and a willingness to engage in the life of the school and its strategic development, over and above merely Accredited School attending meetings. The local governing board welcomes nominations from any eligible parents/carers wishing to stand for election, particularly those with background in strategic planning, education, HR, finance or safeguarding.

All governors serve a four year term of office, even if the child of a parent governor leaves the school before their term of office ends. Being a governor does involve time; there are five governing board meetings each year and governors usually serve on one or more committees which meet approximately once a term. Most meetings start at 6pm and usually last for up to two hours. You will need to set aside time to be able to become an effective governor, including preparing for meetings, carrying out monitoring visits to the school, completing training and updating your knowledge.
