Dear Parents and Carers

## Re: End of Year 11

Students must sign in and out of the event and will not be permitted to leave and later re-enter the venue. Leicester City Football Club and Brockington College have a clear policy on alcohol at the Year 11 Prom. Should any person under the age of 18 appear to be under the influence of alcohol or be found in the possession of alcohol, they will be asked to leave the premises immediately, without refund, and parents/carers will be contacted to arrange collection.

### Brockington College Class of 2023


GCSE results will be available for students to collect from the courtyard on **Thursday 24 August 2023 between 8.00am and 10.00am**. Students will need to collect their results in person, or if they are unable to do so, they may nominate a relative to collect the results for them, provided they have written permission from the student to do so, and can bring photo identification to confirm their identity. Following collection of their results, students are free to open them on site, or to take them away with them to open privately. Members of the Senior Leadership Team and the Pastoral Team will be on hand to answer any questions that you might have regarding results on the day, and next steps for post-16 and careers. Parents/carers are most welcome to accompany their children into the building – you have made significant contributions to get your child to this point and it would be great if you can share the moment with them. I suspect you may have to negotiate with your child around this matter though!

GCSE certificates will be received by the school in November 2023 and we are planning to hold our annual Presentation Evening on **Thursday 23 November 2023 from 6:30pm**; further details will follow in the new academic year. Please save the date!
